Mentee Checklist

This checklist provides clear steps and guidelines to ensure a successful and impactful mentorship.

As Soon as You Are Assigned a Mentor

- $\hfill\square$ Set up an initial meeting to introduce yourselves and get to know each other.
- □ If you feel that your mentor assignment is not a good fit, contact <u>sarah@fmrealtor.com</u>.

During Your First Meeting

- Decide on the frequency of meetings with your mentor and determine the best methods of communication (text, email, etc.).
- □ Learn about what you can gain from attending FMR Connections events. Learn what to expect and how to network.

During Ongoing Meetings

You will gain an understanding of and see the value in:

- □ FMR Committees
- □ FMR Awards
- The FMR Board of Directors and their role
- FMR Events
- □ The FMR website and social media
- □ FMR education sessions (CE Classes, Hot Topics, etc.)

Leading Up to and During Events

- Before the first Connections event, check in with your mentor to ask any questions and make plans to attend together.
- $\hfill\square$ Meet up with your mentor at the event and sit with them.
- $\hfill\square$ Introduce yourself to other REALTOR $^{\ensuremath{^{\oplus}}}$ members and business partners.
- $\hfill\square$ Form connections with other <code>REALTOR</code> $^{\tiny (B)}$ members and business partners.
- $\hfill\square$ Invite others from within or outside of your brokerage to attend.

At the Conclusion of the Mentorship

The mentorship will be considered complete once you as the mentee have:

- □ Attended at least two Connections breakfasts/luncheons.
- □ Invited at least two people to join you at a Connections event.
- □ Attended at least one other FMR event (REALTOR[®] Ring Day, Member Appreciation Week, Golf Tournament, Annual Party, Awards Event, etc.).
- □ Become comfortable using the FMR website to find information throughout the year.
- $\hfill\square$ Gained an understanding of all FMR committees.
- $\hfill\square$ Signed up for or continue to serve on an FMR committee.
- □ Connected with other REALTORS[®] and business partners to build ongoing relationships.
