For 2018, each licensee (unless exempt or new licensee) will be required to complete 9 hours of CE. *Three of these hours must be in a mandatory topic of Agency and will have a CE approval course number with MAN in it.*

- Courses are for all real estate Brokers and Salespersons

- Licensees need a minimum of 9 hours of approved continuing education hours each renewal period. New licensees (as well as those coming out of escrow) have different requirements and should check with the ND Real Estate Commission if additional information is needed.

Note: CE hours must be taken between November 16, 2017 and November 15, 2018 to renew your license for 2019.

- Licensees bear the responsibility for tracking the total number of CE hours they have accrued and submitting proof of CE attendance to their Broker.
